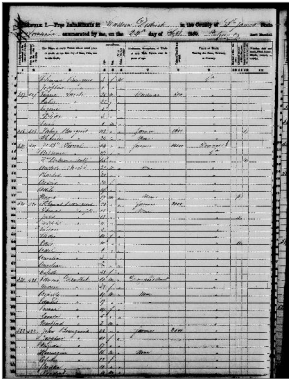

 She is buried in St Michael Cemetery in Convent with husband but LES VOYAGEURS, Sep 2004, p 122, listing of cemetery indicates year of death chipped off stone but she died on 27 Jan. I cannot locate her in the 1880 census. Probably died 27 Jan 1880 but cannot locate in DOBR volumes or the Les Voyageurs index of St Peter, Reserve, funerals. Also, not in 1880 mortality census.
